Muntulgura Guruma Pty Ltd (MGPL) is an Indigenous contracting company providing civil earthworks, rehabilitation and mining services within the Pilbara region of Western Australia. It offers a unique contracting service with the ability to provide a high degree of local Indigenous content.

The company is a 50/50 partnership between iContracting Pty Ltd (iContracting) and HHF Pty Ltd (a company set up to pursue business interests of the Muntulgura Guruma Hughes and Hicks families).

Muntulgura Guruma country covers 6,500 square kilometres around Tom Price and Karijini National Park in the Eastern Pilbara region of Western Australia, and includes mine sites such as FMG Solomon, RTIO Greater Brockman mines, and RTIO Tom Price.

Works undertaken by MGPL involve the employment of Muntulgura Guruma people and the utilisation of local employees and subcontractors wherever possible.
